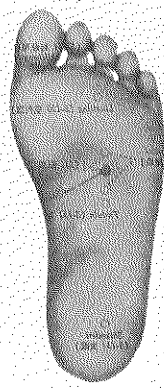
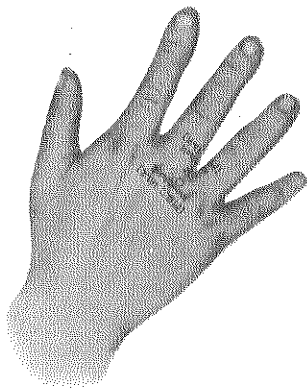


NOSE, HAND AND FOOT ACUPUNCTURE

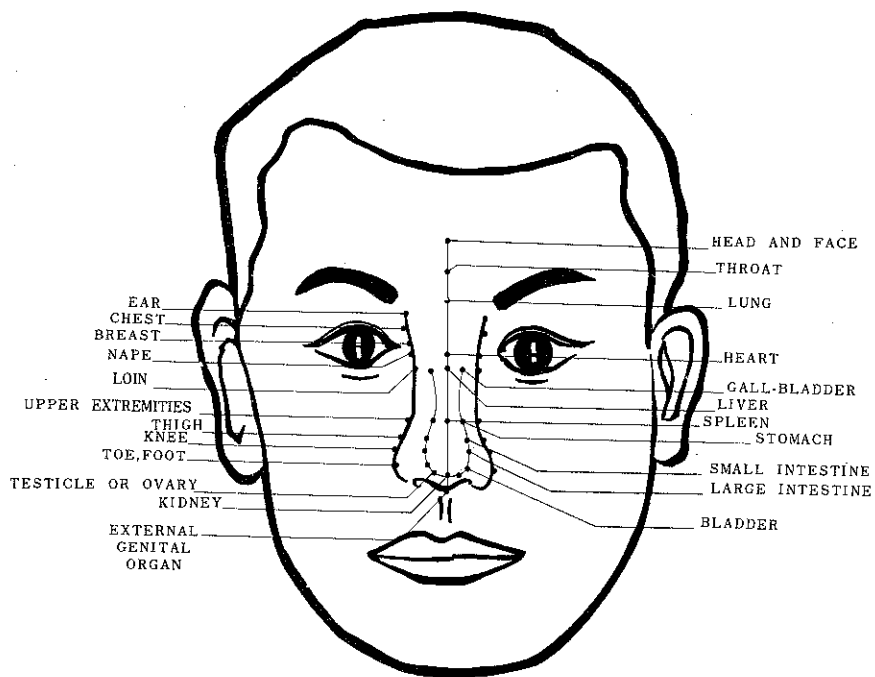


Fig.1 NOSE ACUPUNCTURE

Line two: Yang Hollow Organ (Fu 腑) — situated at both lateral sides of the middle line. Points found in these lines are: Gall-bladder; Stomach; Small intestine; Large intestine; Bladder.

Line three: Chest, Extremities — situated at both lateral sides of line two. Points found in these lines are: Ear; Chest; Breast; Nape; Loin; Upper extremities; thigh; knee; foot and toe.

No numbering of nose acupuncture has been found in ancient documents. All numbers in the following notes are given by the authors, from top to bottom, according to their positions.

It should be noted that these lines of nose acupuncture are not really straight lines. They are formed according to the contour of the nose.

- There are 38 points found on the nose:
 - 8 points at the first line
 - 10 points at the second lines
 - 18 points at the third lines
 - 2 points located beside the first line.

(II) LOCATION OF POINTS

Line one: From the upper one third of forehead to the tip of the philtrum forming the midline of the nose.
